Updates on key projects

Meet City staff and hear about our work to provide new cultural resources, inspiring spaces and accessible facilities for your area.

Burton Street Tabernacle

This treasured heritage building, once a Baptist church, will become a cultural and community hub with a theatre, gallery and cafe/bar. The facility will provide opportunities for artists, cultural groups and the local community to use the space for activities, exhibitions and events. Hear about the concept designs for the new facility and the construction program.



Heffron Hall and adjacent park

Heffron Hall and the adjacent reserve currently provide before and after school care, a community hall and a playground. Following community feedback, we are looking into opportunities to turn the building into a community and creative arts centre, with improved before and after school care facilities and artists' studios. We will update you on this project which includes revitalising the park and playground.



Children's Services

We are working on proposals to use Council's newly purchased building at 277-279 Bourke Street for a childcare centre. This plan would increase the services currently provided by Francis Newton kindergarten, and provide a safer drop-off and collection point for children and safer access between indoor and outdoor play spaces.



Oxford Street/Taylor Square

We are working to revitalise Oxford Street and Taylor Square both culturally and economically. Already underway is the Taylor Square plinth project, featuring a new artwork every few months; the lease of the T2 building to Reverse Garbage and the College of Fine Arts and the fresh food markets.
